

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 218.

Resolved by the board of trustees of the city of Redlands that it is the intention of said board to order the closing and vacating of a certain ~~allied~~ street hereinafter described.

The land deemed necessary to be taken therefor is described as follows;: 1st. ~~For said alley~~: Beginning at the northwesterly corner of lot one of Stones' subdivision of

thence northeasterly along the southerly boundary line of said alley 50 feet; thence northwesterly in line with the easterly boundary line of said lot one (produced) 12 feet; thence southerly along the northerly boundary line of said alley 50 feet; thence southeasterly 12 feet to the place of beginning.

~~2nd. For said street~~: Beginning at the westerly line of Prospect street as it intersects that certain unnamed street lying between blocks 24 and 26 on the north and block 23 on the south, of Redlands Heights, according to Map No. 6 thereof; thence along said un-named street the entire width thereof to the line of intersection with the easterly line of California street.

That the exterior boundaries of the district hereby established, and the exterior boundaries of the district of lands hereby declared to be benefitted by the closing of ~~said alley~~ and of said street, and to be assessed to pay the damage costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows.

1st. ~~For said alley~~: Beginning at the southwest corner of said lot one, thence northerly along the south boundary line of said lot 50 feet; thence northwesterly along the easterly line of said lot 160 feet; thence southwesterly along

the northerly line of said lot 50 feet; thence along the westerly line of said lot to the place of beginning.

2nd. For said street: Beginning at northeasterly corner of said block 26, thence along Crescent Avenue to northwesterly corner said block 24; thence southeasterly along easterly line of said California Street to southerly corner of lot 22 of said block 23; thence to easterly corner of lot 17 of said block; thence along westerly line of Prospect street to beginning.

The Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the street superintendent of said city shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this resolution; and the said superintendent is hereby directed to ~~xxx~~ cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law, and to cause a notice, similar in substance to be published in said newspaper for a period of ten days in the manner required by law.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORK.

Notice is hereby given, that on the 18th day of June, 1903, the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, California, did, at its meeting on said day, pass a resolution declaring its intention to order the following work to be done, to wit:

The closing of an unnamed street in said city hereinafter described.

That the land which was by said Board deemed to be and by its said resolution was declared to be necessary to be taken for said work and improvement, is described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the westerly line of Prospect street as it intersects that certain unnamed street lying between blocks 24 and 26 on the north, and block 28 on the south, of Redlands Heights, according to map No. 6 thereof; thence along said unnamed street the entire width thereof to the line of intersection with the easterly line of California street.

That the exterior boundaries of the district of land established and declared by said resolution to be affected and benefited by said work or improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at northeasterly corner of said block 28; thence along Crescent avenue to northwesterly corner of said block 24; thence southeasterly along easterly line of said California street to southerly corner of lot 22 of said block 28; thence to easterly corner of lot 17 of said block; thence along westerly line of Prospect street to beginning.
