

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CLOSE A PORTION OF WABASH AVENUE
SITUATED IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS.

RESOLVED, that the public interest, convenience and necessity require, and it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Redlands, to order the closing of a portion of Wabash Avenue in the City of Redlands, San Bernardino County, California, to-wit:

All that portion of Section 36, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, according to Government Survey, in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on a curve on the East line of said Section 36, North $0^{\circ} 24'$ East 1032.34 feet from the Southeast corner of said Section 36; thence North $0^{\circ} 24'$ East 812.46 feet along the East line of said Section 36 to a point on a curve to the right whose radius is 225.0 feet and whose initial tangent bears North $26^{\circ} 52'$ West; thence Northwesterly along said curve a distance of 104.82 feet through an angle of $27^{\circ} 16'$ to a point on the West line of Wabash Avenue; thence South $0^{\circ} 24'$ West 1018.13 feet parallel to and 25.0 feet distant from the said East line of Section 36 to the beginning of a curve to the right whose radius is 225.0 feet and whose initial tangent bears North $0^{\circ} 24'$ East; thence Northeasterly along said curve a distance of 106.67 feet through an angle of $27^{\circ} 09' 45''$ to the point of beginning.

RESOLVED FURTHER that the exterior boundaries of the district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the district of lands hereby declared to be affected and benefited by said closing and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof are described as follows:

RESOLVED FURTHER, that notice of the passage of this resolution be given as provided by an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "An Act to provide for laying out, opening, extending, widening, straightening, or closing up in whole or in part, any street, square, lane, alley, court or place within municipalities and to condemn and acquire any and all land and property necessary or convenient for that purpose". (App. Mar. 6th, 1889) and all acts amendatory thereof, and that such notice be published as provided by said act in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper, published and circulated in said City. Further that notice of the passage of this resolution be posted by the Street Superintendent in the manner and form and for the time required by law.
