RESOLUTION NO. 3189

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby elects to proceed under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 2, of the Street and Highways Code of the State of California and to vacate a portion of a street in the manner provided therein.

SECTION TWO: The City Council does hereby declare its intention to order the vacation of a portion of a certain street described as follows:

That portion of an alley as shown on map of Wood Lawn Tract as recorded in Book 15 of Maps, Page 56 in the office of the County Recorder, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Lot 10 as shown on said Tract, with the West line of said alley; thence Northerly along said West line to its intersection with the Southwest line of Interstate Highway 10 (as it now exists); thence Southeasterly along said Southwest line to its intersection with the East line of said alley; thence Southerly along said East line to its intersection with the South line of Lot 11, as shown on said Tract; thence Westerly along the Westerly prolongation of said South line to the Point of Beginning.

SECTION THREE: The City Council hereby determines that the vacation of the portion of the certain street described herein is required by public interest, convenience, safety and welfare.

SECTION FOUR: A map setting the particulars of the proposed street vacation shall be on file in the office of the Public Works Department and available for inspection by persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

SECTION FIVE: The City Council hereby fixes the time and date and place of Public Hearing on the above-described street closing at 7:00 P.M. on the 15th day of July, 1975 in the regular meeting place of the City Council, Redlands, California.

SECTION SIX: Within fifteen days after its passage, this resolution shall be published in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City of Redlands, California.
