RESOLUTION NO. 3477

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS SUPPORTING ASSEMBLY BILL 3659.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redlands as follows:

WHEREAS, existing law does not specifically provide for financial assistance to public agencies seeking to reduce their use of energy;

WHEREAS, rapidly increasing energy costs are becoming an ever-increasing portion of governmental budgets; and

WHEREAS, energy conservation techniques have been demonstrated to be the best way of meeting future energy demands and extending the use of limited energy resources into the future; and

WHEREAS, increasing efficiencies of energy using systems is recognized as one of the most cost-effective methods of reducing energy demands;

WHEREAS, most public agencies lack the financial resources necessary to initiate programs to improve the efficiency of their energy using

WHEREAS, AB 3659 would provide for the allocation of funds to public agencies requesting assistance in improving their use of energy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Redlands supports and urges the passage of AB 3659 by the State Legislature and its signing by the Governor.
