

RESOLUTION No. 1015

Resolution of the City of Redlands concerning Assembly Bill No. 22.

WHEREAS, proposed Assembly Bill No. 22 is an act to amend Section 100.25 of the Streets and Highways Code relating to the inclusion in the agreement of consideration for master plans of streets and highways of cities and counties.

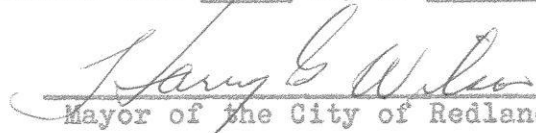
WHEREAS, it is desirable that provisions for improvements, revisions or extensions of city streets leading to or from a freeway, deemed by the contracting agencies to be necessary in accommodating the freeway traffic in making proper connections between the existing or contemplated system of city streets into the freeway, may be included in agreements between the City and the State Highway Department and the department may perform such work as a part of the freeway construction; if the street or highway is at such time a part of the city street system or county highway system or is included in an officially adopted master plan of streets or highways of such city or county.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That the adoption of proposed Assembly Bill No. 22 is in the public interest and promotes the health, safety and welfare of the City of Redlands.

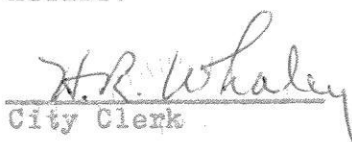
2. That this City Council endorses said Assembly Bill No. 22 and urges its enactment.
