

RESOLUTION NO. 804

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND CONVENIENCE REQUIRES THE SALE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC PROPERTY AND STATING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS TO SELL THE PROPERTY.

The City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby elects to proceed under the provisions of Division 3, Part 2, Chapter 5 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California and to adopt a resolution of intention to sell certain property in the manner provided therein.

SECTION TWO: This City Council does hereby declare that it is the intention of this City Council to sell certain public property located at the intersection of Texas Street and State Street, (Center Street and West Citrus Avenue) described as follows:

All that real property situated in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, bounded and described as follows:

A portion of Block 29 as per Map of Barton Ranch recorded in Book 6 of Maps, page 19, records of said County, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Southerly line of the 50 foot wide Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way and the West line of 80 foot wide Texas Street; thence Southerly along the West line of said Texas Street to its intersection with the Northerly line of 65 foot wide State Street; thence along said Northerly line of State Street to a point 140 feet west of the West line of Texas Street; thence Northerly along a line parallel to and 140 feet from the West line of Texas Street to the Southerly line of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way; thence Northeasterly along said Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to the point of beginning.

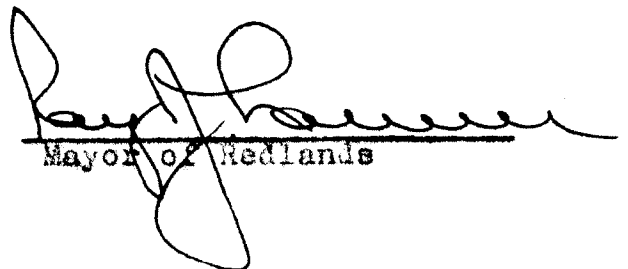
SECTION THREE: The City Council hereby determines that the sale of the public property described herein in Section Two is required by public interest, convenience, safety and welfare.

SECTION FOUR: A map setting out the boundaries of the property to be sold shall be on file in the office of the City Clerk and available for inspection by interested persons.

SECTION FIVE: The City Council hereby fixes the time and date and place of hearing protests to the sale of the above-described public property at 8:00 P. M. on the 3rd day of September, 1957, in

the regular meeting place of the City Council of the City of Redlands in the City Hall, Redlands, California, at which time and place final action will be taken.

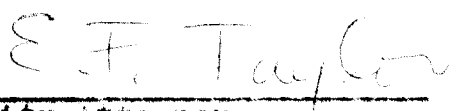
