

RESOLUTION NO. 943

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO CITY OF REDLANDS TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 67 OF REDLANDS ORDINANCE CODE.

Pursuant to studies heretofore made under authority of this City Council and the presentation of the information gained in such studies, the City Council hereby finds and determines that traffic conditions and the convenience of the public require that certain regulations are necessary and shall be established, pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Redlands Ordinance Code, and the Traffic Engineer of the City of Redlands is hereby directed to perform such acts as are necessary to accomplish the following:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to Article 676, Section 676.1 of the Redlands Traffic Ordinance:

1. To establish Elizabeth Street as a through highway from Crescent Avenue to Garden Street except at Garden Street.

SECTION TWO: Pursuant to Article 677, Sections 677.1 and 677.9 of Chapter 67 of the Redlands Ordinance Code, Parking:

1. To repeal Ordinance No. 967 of the City of Redlands prohibiting the parking of vehicles for a time longer than two hours on Eureka Street from South curb of Library Drive south to a point approximately 300 feet south on east and west side of street and on Fourth Street approximately 300 feet south on east and west side of street.
