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RESOLUTION NO. 2777

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS PURSUANT
TO CHAPTER 67 OF THE REDLANDS ORDINANCE CODE

Pursuant to studies made under authority of Chapter 67 of the Redlands Ordinance Code, and the presentation of information gained in such studies, the City Council hereby finds and determines that traffic conditions and the convenience of the public require that certain regulations are necessary and shall be established, pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Redlands Ordinance Code, and the Traffic Engineer of the City of Redlands is hereby directed to perform such acts as are necessary to accomplish the following:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to Article 678, Section 67801 (b) of the Redlands Traffic Ordinance and Article 621, Section 62102 of the Parking Meter Ordinance:

1. Eliminate loading zones and green zones in the following areas:
 - (a) North side of State Street between Third and Fourth Streets.
 - (b) East side of Third Street from State Street north to alley.
 - (c) West side of Fourth Street from State Street north to alley.
2. Install parking meters in these spaces in the following areas:
 - (a) North side of State Street between Third and Fourth Streets.
 - (b) East side of Third Street from State Street north to alley.
 - (c) West side of Fourth Street from State Street north to alley.
