

RESOLUTION NO. 3448

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 67 OF THE REDLANDS ORDINANCE CODE

Pursuant to studies made in accordance with Chapter 67 of the Redlands Ordinance Code, and the presentation of information gained in such studies, the City Council hereby finds and determines that traffic conditions and the convenience of the public require that certain regulations are necessary and shall be established.

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to Section 40802 (b) of the California Vehicle Code and Article 680, Sections 68001 (a) of the Redlands Traffic Ordinance, the following highway has been studied and the following speed limits are hereby found most appropriate to facilitate the orderly movement of traffic and is reasonable and safe:

Highway: Orange st. between the North city limits and Vine st.

Date of Study: February 14, 1978

Speed Limits as Follows:

State maximum between the North city limits and Pioneer ave.

45 m.p.h. Between Pioneer ave. and San Bernardino ave.

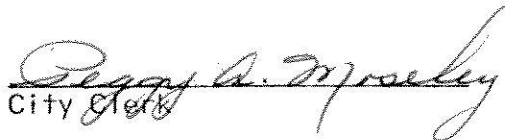
35 m.p.h. Between San Bernardino ave. and Lugonia ave.

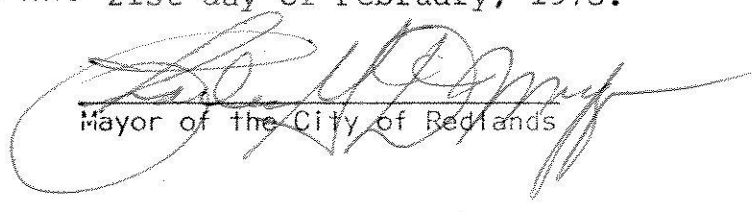
30 m.p.h. Between Lugonia ave. and Colton ave.

25 m.p.h. Between Colton ave. and Vine st.
