

RESOLUTION NO. 659

WHEREAS, the records of the Water Department of the City of Redlands definitely indicate a general lowering of the subterranean water tables, and

WHEREAS, these same records show a declination in the volume of surface waters available, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redlands in an effort to combat an approaching emergency and to assure the domestic water users a continuity of water service,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Water Department of the City of Redlands shall discontinue the installation of new services and extensions, except wherein commitments exist, to all territory west of the west city limits, and to all territory north of the Mill Creek and Santa Ana Wash,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Water Department of the City of Redlands shall discontinue the installation of new extensions in all other areas outside of the confines of the incorporate city limits and shall install new services only wherein existing distribution lines exist.
